Most importantly we are continuing to control expenses so that for the first seven months of 2007 we have a positive balance. Again please keep in mind that this is a result of the many cutbacks in employees and programs that we had to make to balance the budget. We now need to start looking at what we as a city need to do to restore some of these cuts For the rest of 2007 we are going to evaluate our financial condition and see how we end up on December 31. Therefore it is the administrations decision not to ask for any levy from our residents in November.
