It's Baseball Time again in Eastlake. We have negotiated the use of a loge at the Captains Stadium for the 2010 season. The City will be holding a drawing and giving out tickets to three families for games this season. Please come to the Mayor's office and fill out a chance for the drawing. This is for Eastlake residents ONLY, and verification of residency must be shown. The drawings will take place in March for April games, April for May games etc. We will notify the winners to come in and pick up their tickets. The City and team are doing this as a thank you to Eastlake residents for their support of the team. The City will also use the loge for Economic Development events during the season as a way to attract new businesses and to thank our existing businesses for staying in Eastlake.

Also from the Captains is a special price of \$2 a ticket for Eastlake residents for games from opening day April 8 until May 12. These tickets can be purchased at the Classic Park Box Office. This promotion for Eastlake residents ONLY is another thank-you from the team and the city for all of the support from Eastlake residents for the Lake County Captains.
