Hello Residents:

The popular Saturday Night Car Cruises have begun. The Car Cruises are organized and sponsored by Sarducci's Pizza and are held between 4 p.m. and 8 p.m. behind City Hall and on the Boulevard of Flags. There is music, refreshments and of course Classic Cars. It is a nice family event so try to come out one or two Saturdays this summer.

Also starting this month is our City sponsored Flea market at the parking lot on Vine Street. The Flea market starts on Saturday, May 28 and runs through September. The cost is a very reasonable \$10 per parking place. The hours of operation are 8 a.m. until 1 p.m. but vendors can set up early to get a preferred spot. All proceeds go towards reducing the Stadium Debt.

It is getting closer to our pool opening on June 4, weather permitting. Pool passes are now on sale in our Finance department at a cost of \$95 for your entire family, \$50 individual passes and \$20 for seniors age 55 and over. We have also extended the City of Eastlake rate to our neighbors in Timberlake and Lakeline Villages. Daily pool passes will also be sold at \$5 per day. I would highly recommend the pool pass for your best value and would encourage residents not to wait until the last minute to buy their passes.

The Fourth of July Fireworks will be held at Classic Park. Doors will open at 7 p.m. and the Fireworks will begin when it is dark enough, usually around 9:45 -10 p.m. All community groups that would like to have a table on the concourse as in past years please call the Mayor's office at 951-1416, ext 102. There will be music and Captain's baseball promotions leading up to the Fireworks. Concessions will be open.

The City of Eastlake Home Days will be held July 28- 31 at the festival grounds at the corner of Lakeshore and Erie Roads. The annual City parade will be on Saturday, July 30. The parade will begin at noon.
