Hello Residents:

Opening day for the Lake County Captains has arrived and we wish them a successful winning season. When attending games this year and you need to park please try to park in the city-owned parking lot at the corner of Route 91 and Vine Street. The parking revenue the city collects is shared with various city groups such as sports leagues, Girl Scouts, the Eastlake Women's Club and the VFW. The rest of the revenue goes to reducing the stadium debt. The cost of \$5 is the same as the other lots.

Swimming pool passes are available for purchase right now in our Finance department. The cost for a season pass is very affordable at \$95 for an entire family, \$50 for an individual and \$20 for a senior citizen over the age of 55. Daily passes will also be available at 5 per day. The pool weather permitting is scheduled to open on Saturday, June 4. We will once again be doing swimming lessons at just \$25 per child for eight lessons. Please refer to our website for further details on swimming lesson dates and signups. We are accepting applications for summer lifeguards at the service department. Lifeguards must have all the necessary certifications.

There has been some confusion and false information being given out by some stores and contractors concerning installation permit fees for hot water tanks and furnaces. The permit fee for a hot water tank installation is \$30.30 and for a furnace is \$40.30. That is the total cost for a permit. Some contractors are saying our fee is over \$100. So as a resident you should pay only these amounts to your contractor for a permit fee. I would encourage all residents to get the permit to insure that the installation work is done according to code. Especially with gas installations it is extremely important to avoid gas leaks. We have all seen and read the dangerous situations with improperly installed gas water heaters and furnaces.

Once again we will be having our fireworks show at the Stadium on July 4th. Also the City festival is scheduled for July 28 through July 31 at the Erie Road and Lakeshore sites. If you would like to participate in the festival as a merchant or vendor please call the Mayor's office for costs and details. The city parade will be held on Saturday, July 30.
