Dear Residents:

The City of Eastlake has the Road Levy Renewal on the ballot November 2. The important item here is that this is a RENEWAL LEVY which means absolutely no increase in taxes. Every five years this levy comes up for renewal and the amount collected does not change. This levy is extremely important to our city. It brings in about \$1.3 million dollars which is used to fix our city's roads. This levy can only be used for this purpose and does not go for any other city expense. In recent years we have used the road levy money to redo Reeves Road, Erie Road, South Lakeshore, Roberts Road (both sides) and this year East 347th and 348th streets. In addition our Service Department paves 10-12 roads per year using the funds from this levy to buy the asphalt. We ask that the residents support the renewal of the Road Levy with a yes vote on November 2.

Leaf pickup starts the first week of November. Please remember to put your leaves on the tree lawn or in the ditches in front of your house. Please do not put the leaves in the street. The leaves if put on the street find their way into the storm sewers and then block the sewers causing water backups in the area. Also please try to keep branches and anything other than leaves out of the ditches. Anything other than leaves will cause the leaf machines to break and cause a delay in the pickup process. If at all possible please try to bag some of your leaves and put them out for the yard waste pickup. This also helps the city workers pick up the leaves faster.
